For a valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and to induce you to honor from time to time at your sole option the purchase orders of _____ (Herein called "Purchaser") without requiring payment upon delivery, each of the undersigned Guarantors as a primary obligor, jointly and severally, unconditionally guarantees to you, your successors and assigns, that Purchaser fully, promptly and faithfully will perform, pay and discharge all of the Purchaser's obligations, and agrees without your first having to proceed against Purchaser or any other person, firm or corporation, to pay on demand all sums due or become due to you from Purchaser under any agreement between Purchaser and yourself, and all losses, costs, attorney's fees or expenses which you may suffer by reason of Purchaser's default.

This Continuing Guaranty may be terminated only by notice sent to you by certified mail, stating an effective date after the receipts of such notice by you, but shall continue thereafter as to each of us who has not given such notice, and shall continue as to each of us giving such notice with respect to any obligation of Purchaser to you as of the date such notice is received by you. No termination hereof shall be effected by the death of any or all of us. Each of us waives notice of acceptance thereof and of presentment, demand, protest, and notice of non-payable or endorsed or assigned to you by said Purchaser, and we waive all setoffs and counterclaims whatsoever.

You may without notice to us, review, extend, or transfer such obligation of Purchaser; accept partial payments thereon; or settle, release on terms satisfactory to you or by operation of law such obligation or security therefore in any manner; or consent to the transfer of such security therefore in any manner; or consent to the transfer of such security without affecting or impairing such obligation of any of us hereunder.

No payment by Guarantor hereunder shall entitle that Guarantor, by subrogation or otherwise, to any payment by Purchaser under or out of the property of Purchaser, except after payment in full to you of such obligation contingently, absolutely, or otherwise payable by Purchaser to you.

This Instrument shall bind our respective heirs, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns, and shall inure your successors and assigns. All of the rights are cumulative and not alternative. Witness our hand(s) and seal(s) the day and year first above written.

Privacy Statement

General Information

Daniel G. Schuster, LLC (Schuster Concrete) respects the privacy of our customers, business partners and employees. We recognize the need for appropriate protections and management of your personal information that you provide to us. Schuster Concrete has therefore established this Privacy Statement to help you to understand what information we collect and how that information is used. This Privacy Statement applies to Daniel G. Schuster, LLC including its subsidiaries and divisions.

What Personal Information Does Schuster Concrete Collect?

Personal Information is information that can be used to contact or identify a specific individual, such as social security number, name, address, and telephone number. Schuster Concrete may collect certain personal information from employees, candidates for employment, business partners, and customers.

Schuster Concrete also collects personal information of its employees (Human Resource and Payroll data) in connection with the administration of its Human Resource and Payroll programs. These functions and programs include compensation and benefit programs, training, business travel, expense reimbursement, Human Resource recordkeeping, and other employment related purposes. Medical data including drug test results, DOT physical results, information related to Workers Compensation injuries and short term disability claims is also collected and maintained by Schuster Concrete.

How Does Schuster Concrete Use Personal Information?

Schuster Concrete will use personal information provided by customers and business partners to help you complete an order, to communicate with you, to deliver products/services to you, to bill you for products/services you have purchased, and to provide ongoing service and support.

Schuster Concrete uses personal information to consider candidates for employment opportunities. Schuster Concrete uses personal information about its employees in connection with the administration of its Payroll and Human Resources programs and functions, and for the purpose of communicating with its employees.

Except as provided in this statement, Schuster Concrete does not use your personal information for a purpose other than the stated purposes for which such information is collected.

With Whom Does Schuster Concrete Share Personal Information?

Occasionally Schuster Concrete may need to share personal information with its service providers and suppliers solely, and only to the extent needed, to support the customers' business needs. Service providers and suppliers are required to keep confidential any personal information given to them by Schuster Concrete, and may not use it for any purpose other than as originally intended.

Human Resources and Payroll data may be shared with third party vendors for the exclusive purpose of enabling the vendor to provide service and/or support to Schuster Concrete in connection with Benefit Programs, Human Resource, and Payroll programs and functions. Personal data is not shared with third parties for non-employment related purposes.

Third parties receiving personal information are expected to apply the same level of privacy protection as contained in the Privacy Statement.

Except as provided above, Schuster Concrete will not share personal information with any other third parties without your permission, unless required by, or in connection with, law enforcement action, subpoena or other litigation, or applicable law.

Schuster Concrete will not sell, trade, or lease your personal information to others.

Sensitive Information

Sensitive information is defined as personal information specifying medical or health conditions, racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious beliefs, or sexual preference of an individual.

Schuster Concrete may receive sensitive information such as medical or health conditions, or race and ethnic data regarding its employees in connection with the administration of its health and welfare benefit plans, or as part of government mandated recordkeeping requirements. Such information will not be shared with third parties without the employee's written consent. Sensitive information will not be used for purposes other than those originally intended without the employee's approval.

Choice and Consent

Schuster Concrete does not require that you provide us with personal information. The decision to provide personal information is voluntary. If, however, you do not wish to provide the personal information requested, you may not be able to proceed with the activity or receive the benefit for which the personal information is being requested.

Security of Personal Information

Schuster Concrete is committed to taking reasonable efforts to secure the personal data that you choose to provide to us. To protect the privacy of any personal information you may have provided, Schuster Concrete employs industry-standard controls including but not limited to physical access controls, encrypted communications, network monitoring, security policies, and internet firewalls. In addition, access to sensitive data as defined in this statement is limited to those individuals and agents having a need to know.
